CHAPTER 3
ESTABLISHING THE COUNTY SUPERVISOR DISTRICTS AND ELECTION PRECINCTS

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3.01 PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish County Supervisor Districts and Election Precincts as the result of the population changes reflected by the 2010 Federal Census, in accordance with Iowa Code Sections 49.7 and 331.210A.

3.02 LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF DISTRICTS:

District #1-Population 813 shall encompass the following:

Ward 1- All that portion of the City lying south of a line along the centerline of Eighth Street where it meets the western corporate limits, then east to the centerline of Nodaway, thence one block south to the centerline of Seventh Street, thence east to the centerline of Adams Street, thence one block north to centerline of Eighth Street, thence east along centerline of Eighth Street to the centerline of Highway 148, thence south along the centerline of Highway 148 to the railroad line, thence east along the railroad line to the corporate line. Ward 1 has a total of 551 people as per census count;

AND all that portion south and east of the centerline of the Corning-Carl Road (N 53) in Quincy Township having a population of 25;

AND all that portion of Prescott Township east of the Corning Carl Road and west of Quince Avenue (N61) (excluding the Town of Prescott) having a population of 140;

AND all that portion of Jasper Township east of Highway 148 and north of 240th Street having a population of 97.

District #2-Population 809 shall encompass the following:

Ward 2 - All that portion of the City lying north of a line along the centerline of Eighth Street where it meets the western corporate limits, then east to the centerline of Nodaway, thence one block south to the centerline of Seventh Street, thence east to the centerline of Adams Street, thence one block north to centerline of Eighth Street, thence east along centerline of Eighth Street to the centerline of Highway 148, thence south along the centerline of Highway 148 to the railroad line, thence east along the railroad line to the corporate line and south of west corporate limits of intersection of Joshua Tree Avenue and Hull Street to the centerline of Ninth Street, thence east along centerline of Ninth Street, thence north on the centerline of Loomis Avenue to the centerline of Westgate Drive, thence east along the centerline of Twelfth Street to the centerline of Grove Avenue, thence north to the centerline of Thirteenth Street, thence east along the centerline of Thirteenth Street to the centerline of Quincy Avenue, thence one block south to the centerline of Twelfth Street, thence east along the centerline of Twelfth Street, thence to centerline of John Street north to the centerline of Fifteenth Street, thence east to the corporate line. Ward 2 has a total of 540 people as per census count;

AND all that portion of Jasper Township west of the centerline of Highway 148 and south of the centerline of 240th Street with a population of 215;

AND all that portion of Nodaway Township east of the centerlines of Fig and Elm Avenues having a population of 21;

AND all that portion of Quincy Township south of the centerline of 210th Street (H34) having a population of 33.

District #3-Population 795 shall encompass the following:

Ward 3 - All that portion of the City lying north of the centerline of Hull Street from the west corporate limit at 1400 Hull Street (northwest corner of census block 190039502001008) to the centerline of Ninth Street, thence east along the centerline of Ninth Street to the centerline of Loomis Avenue, thence north on the centerline of Loomis Avenue to the centerline of Westgate Drive, thence east along the centerline of Westgate Drive and continuing along the centerline of Twelfth Street to the centerline of Grove Avenue, thence north to the centerline of Thirteenth Street, thence east to centerline of Quincy Avenue, thence south one

block to centerline of Twelfth Street, thence east on Twelfth Street to the centerline of John Street thence north to centerline of Fifteenth Street, thence east to the corporate limits. Ward 3 has a total of 544 people as per census count;

AND all that portion of Quincy Township north of the centerline of 210th Street (H34) and north and west of the centerline of the Corning-Carl Road having a population of 172;

AND all that portion of Douglas Township east and north of 210th Street (N34) and the centerline of Elm Street having a population of 35;

AND all of the City of Carbon having a population of 34;

AND all that portion of Prescott Township west of the centerline of the Corning-Carl Road having a population of 10.

District #4-Population 803 shall encompass the following:

All of the City of Nodaway having a population of 114;

AND all of that portion of Nodaway Township west of the centerlines of Fig and Elm Avenues having a population of 100;

AND all that portion of Douglas Township west and south of the centerlines of 210th Street (N34) and Elm Avenue having a population of 89;

AND all of Lincoln Township having a population of 79;

AND all of Washington Township having a population of 135;

AND all of Carl Township having a population of 149;

AND all of that portion of Colony Township north of the centerline of 150th Street (H24) to Walnut Avenue and west of the centerline of Walnut Avenue to the centerline of 120th Street (H20) and north of the centerline of 120th Street (H20) to the county line having a population of 137.

District #5-Population 809 shall encompass the following:

All of Mercer Township having a population of 153;

AND all of Grant Township having a population of 201 including that portion of the City of Lenox that lies within Adams County;

AND all of Union Township having a population of 144;

AND all that portion of Prescott Township east of the centerline of Quince Avenue having a population of 17;

AND all of the City of Prescott having a population of 257;

AND all that portion of Colony Township that lies south of the centerline of 150th Street (H24) to the centerline of Walnut Avenue and east of the centerline of Walnut Avenue to 120th Street (H20) and south of the centerline of 120th Street to the county line having a population of 37.

3.03 LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF PRECINCTS:

All voting precincts for cities within Adams County shall be established by ordinance by their respective City Councils. All remaining voting precincts shall be designated as follows:

PRECINCT #1- “Adams 1” - Population 813 shall encompass the following:

Ward 1- All that portion of the City lying south of a line along the centerline of Eighth Street where it meets the western corporate limits, then east to the centerline of Nodaway, thence one block south to the centerline of Seventh Street, thence east to the centerline of Adams Street, thence one block north to centerline of Eighth Street, thence east along centerline of Eighth Street to the centerline of Highway 148, thence south along the centerline of Highway 148 to the railroad line, thence east along the railroad line to the corporate line. Ward 1 has a total of 551 people as per census count;

AND all that portion south and east of the centerline of the Corning-Carl Road (N 53) in Quincy Township having a population of 25;

AND all that portion of Prescott Township east of the Corning Carl Road and west of Quince Avenue (N61) (excluding the Town of Prescott) having a population of 140;

AND all that portion of Jasper Township east of Highway 148 and north of 240th Street having a population of 97.

PRECINCT #2- “Adams 2” - Population 809 shall encompass the following:

Ward 2 - All that portion of the City lying north of a line along the centerline of Eighth Street where it meets the western corporate limits, then east to the centerline of Nodaway, thence one block south to the centerline of Seventh Street, thence east to the centerline of Adams Street, thence one block north to centerline of Eighth Street, thence east along centerline of Eighth Street to the centerline of Highway 148, thence south along the centerline of Highway 148 to the railroad line, thence east along the railroad line to the corporate line and south of west corporate limits of intersection of Joshua Tree Avenue and Hull Street to the centerline of Ninth Street, thence east along centerline of Ninth Street, thence north on the centerline of Loomis Avenue to the centerline of Westgate Drive, thence east along the centerline of Twelfth Street to the centerline of Grove Avenue, thence north to the centerline of Thirteenth Street, thence east along the centerline of Thirteenth Street to the centerline of Quincy Avenue, thence one block south to the centerline of Twelfth Street, thence east along the centerline of Twelfth Street, thence to centerline of John Street north to the centerline of Fifteenth Street, thence east to the corporate line. Ward 2 has a total of 540 people as per census count;

AND all that portion of Jasper Township west of the centerline of Highway 148 and south of the centerline of 240th Street with a population of 215;

AND all that portion of Nodaway Township east of the centerlines of Fig and Elm Avenues having a population of 21;

AND all that portion of Quincy Township south of the centerline of 210th Street (H34) having a population of 33.

PRECINCT #3- “Adams 3” - Population 795 shall encompass the following:

Ward 3 - All that portion of the City lying north of the centerline of Hull Street from the west corporate limit at 1400 Hull Street (northwest corner of census block 190039502001008) to the centerline of Ninth Street, thence east along the centerline of Ninth Street to the centerline of Loomis Avenue, thence north on the centerline of Loomis Avenue to the centerline of Westgate Drive, thence east along the centerline of Westgate Drive and continuing along the centerline of Twelfth Street to the centerline of Grove Avenue, thence north to the centerline of Thirteenth Street, thence east to centerline of Quincy Avenue, thence south one block to centerline of Twelfth Street, thence east on Twelfth Street to the centerline of John Street thence north to centerline of Fifteenth Street, thence east to the corporate limits. Ward 3 has a total of 544 people as per census count;

AND all that portion of Quincy Township north of the centerline of 210th Street (H34) and north and west of the centerline of the Corning-Carl Road having a population of 172;

AND all that portion of Douglas Township east and north of 210th Street (N34) and the centerline of Elm Street having a population of 35;

AND all of the City of Carbon having a population of 34;

AND all that portion of Prescott Township west of the centerline of the Corning-Carl Road having a population of 10.

PRECINCT #4- “Adams 4” - Population 803 shall encompass the following:

All of the City of Nodaway having a population of 114;

AND all of that portion of Nodaway Township west of the centerlines of Fig and Elm Avenues having a population of 100;

AND all that portion of Douglas Township west and south of the centerlines of 210th Street (N34) and Elm Avenue having a population of 89;

AND all of Lincoln Township having a population of 79;

AND all of Washington Township having a population of 135;

AND all of Carl Township having a population of 149;

AND all of that portion of Colony Township north of the centerline of 150th Street (H24) to Walnut Avenue and west of the centerline of Walnut Avenue to the centerline of 120th Street (H20) and north of the centerline of 120th Street (H20) to the county line having a population of 137.

PRECINCT #5- “Adams 5” - Population 809 shall encompass the following:

All of Mercer Township having a population of 153;

AND all of Grant Township having a population of 201 including that portion of the City of Lenox that lies within Adams County;

AND all of Union Township having a population of 144;

AND all that portion of Prescott Township east of the centerline of Quince Avenue having a population of 17;

AND all of the City of Prescott having a population of 257;

AND all that portion of Colony Township that lies south of the centerline of 150th Street (H24) to the centerline of Walnut Avenue and east of the centerline of Walnut Avenue to 120th Street (H20) and south of the centerline of 120th Street to the county line having a population of 37.

3.04 SEVERABILITY: If any section, provision or part of this ordinance is adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication will not affect the validity of the Code of Ordinances as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
